IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That in the event said payment has not been made within ten (10) days from this date, or, in the alternative, that the required 1974 Annual Report has not been filed within ten (10) days from this date, Counsel for the Commission is ordered and directed to proceed against H. S. & G. Drilling Company, Telephone Answering Service to recover the penalty invoked herein in a proceeding in the Franklin Circuit Court.
