EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

BellSouth Service Quality Measurement Plan (SQM)

The BellSouth Service Quality Measurement Plan (SQM) describes in detail the measurements produced to evaluate the quality of service delivered to BellSouth's customers both wholesale and retail. The SQM was developed to respond to the requirements of the Communications Act of 1996 Section 251 (96 Act) which required BellSouth to provide non-discriminatory access to Competitive Local Exchange Carriers (CLEC) and its Retail Customers. The reports produced by the SQM provide regulators, CLECs and BellSouth the information necessary to monitor the delivery of nondiscriminatory access.

This version of the Kentucky SQM reflects the Orders of the Georgia Public Service Commission, Docket 7872-U, issued on November 14, 2002, January 22, 2003 and July 3, 2003, as adopted by the Kentucky Public Service Commission, Case No. 2001-00105, in its Orders of May 11, 2004 and June 14, 2004.

The SQM and the reports flowing from it must change to reflect the dynamic requirements of the industry. New measurements are added as new products, systems, and processes are developed and fielded. New products and services are added as the markets for them develop and the processes stabilize. The measurements are also changed to reflect changes in systems, correct errors, and respond to both 3rd Party audit requirements and the Georgia PSC.

This document is intended for use by someone with knowledge of telecommunications industry, information technologies and a functional knowledge of the subject areas covered by the BellSouth Performance Measurements and the reports that flow from them.

Kentucky Self-Effectuating Enforcement Mechanism (SEEM) Administrative Plan

This Administrative Plan ("Plan") includes Service Quality Measurements ("SQM") with corresponding Self Effectuating Enforcement Mechanisms ("SEEM") to be implemented by BellSouth pursuant to the Orders issued by the Georgia Public Service Commission in Docket 7892-U.

In providing services pursuant to the Interconnection Agreements between BellSouth and each CLEC, BellSouth will report its performance to each CLEC in accordance with BellSouth's SQMs and applicable SEEM, which are posted on the Performance Measurement Reports website.
