

PROPOSED JANUARY 2008 DATA NOTIFICATION

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a AT&T Kentucky (“AT&T Kentucky”) is considering making the changes described in this document to generate results for the January 2008 data month. Results for the January 2008 data month will be posted as follows:

Preliminary results	February 20, 2008
Final results	February 29, 2008

AT&T Kentucky provides Data Notifications each month in compliance with the SQM Plan. This order specifies that when AT&T Kentucky proposes making any changes to the methods by which performance data is calculated, it must provide written notice. This notice must be provided on the first business day of the month before the data month in which the change will be made. AT&T Kentucky must also provide notification if it is considering making changes to the method of calculating data for the following month.

ENCORE Releases may affect monthly data flows from the source systems (e.g., LEO, LESOG, etc.) that PMAP uses to calculate measurements. AT&T Kentucky will make changes to PMAP to ensure that data continues to be correctly captured as ENCORE Releases are implemented.

System releases related to the merger between BellSouth and AT&T may affect monthly data flows from the source systems that PMAP uses to calculate measurements. AT&T Kentucky will make changes to PMAP to ensure that data continues to be correctly captured as system changes are implemented.

Provisioning Measurements

- (1) *Affected Measures:* P-4 (OCI) – Kentucky Only

Description of Change: Currently, AT&T Kentucky uses two data sources to identify data for the UNE Other Non-Design product group in Kentucky. This causes the result for this product to be doubled. AT&T Kentucky proposes to eliminate one of the data sources to provide the correct results. (RQ9397)

Impact of Change: For August 2007 data, the OCI results for UNE Other Non-Design (Dispatch) in Georgia would change from 9.46 days to 4.73 days.

For August 2007 data, the OCI results for UNE Other Non-Design (Non-Dispatch) in Georgia would change from 9.68 days to 4.84 days.

Due to the impact of this change, re-posting is not necessary.

(2) *Affected Measures:* P-4 (OCI)

Description of Change: For some LNP transactions, the system is not applying the "L" appointment code for transactions where the customer has requested a later than offered interval. AT&T Kentucky proposes to modify the PMAP code to recognize these orders as "L" appointment coded in accordance with the exclusions for this measurement. This proposed change was not on the Preliminary January 2008 Data Notification filed on November 2, 2007. (RQ9495)

Impact of Change: For August 2007 data, the OCI results for UNE Analog Loop Design with LNP metric in Florida would change from 4.67 days to 4.22 days. The OCI results for UNE Analog Loop Non-Design with LNP metric in Florida would change from 4.00 days to 3.63 days.

For August 2007 data, the OCI results for UNE Analog Loop Design with LNP metric in Georgia would remain as 4.00 days. The OCI results for UNE Analog Loop Non-Design with LNP metric in Georgia would change from 3.20 days to 3.02 days.

Due to the impact of this change, re-posting is not necessary.
