Dear Mr. Dorman:

On March 15, 2002 the Commission issued an order in Case No. 1998-00348 approving the Company's Statement of Generally Available Terms and Conditions (SGAT) with one modification and requiring the filing of the SGAT as a separate section of the tariff. The required tariff is enclosed. Section XIV, paragraph F has been revised per the Commission's order.

In the Commission's Order in Administrative Case 382 dated December 18, 2001, the Commission approved Unbundled Network Element prices for BellSouth. Non-recurring charges for disconnect activity were included in these prices. With this filing the Company is voluntarily removing the "disconnect" portion of non-recurring charges.

The enclosed filing reflects an issue and effective date of March 28, 2002 which complies with the Commission's Order in 1998-00348. We are filing this today to give the Commission adequate notice of the effective price reductions involved in the elimination of disconnect charges.

Once approved, administrative notice of this tariff filing will be made in both Case 2001-105 where the SGAT is an exhibit to the testimony of Ms. Cynthia Cox and in Administrative Case 382.
