
Dear Mr. Dorman:

We are filing today revisions to PSC KY Tariff 10C, Attachment 3, the Kentucky Statement of Generally Available Terms and Conditions ("SGAT") and Attachment C thereto. Enclosed under Tab 1 are "red-lined" versions of these documents that reflect the proposed changes and under Tab 2 the final documents which replace the SGAT and Attachment C thereto in their entirety. No rates are changing with this filing, therefore the proposed effective date of the filing is June 18, 2002.

On May 13, 2002 the U. S. Supreme Court issued its order Case No. 00-511 regarding TELRIC pricing and the combination of unbundled elements. BellSouth is revising its SGAT to incorporate this decision. With this change, BellSouth will make combinations not typically combined in BellSouth's network available through the Bona Fide Request ("BFR") process. The price for such elements will also be negotiated through the BFR process. The change made today specifically incorporates this language in SGAT Attachment C and the Terms and Conditions portion of the SGAT is modified to reflect that Attachment C contains these details.
