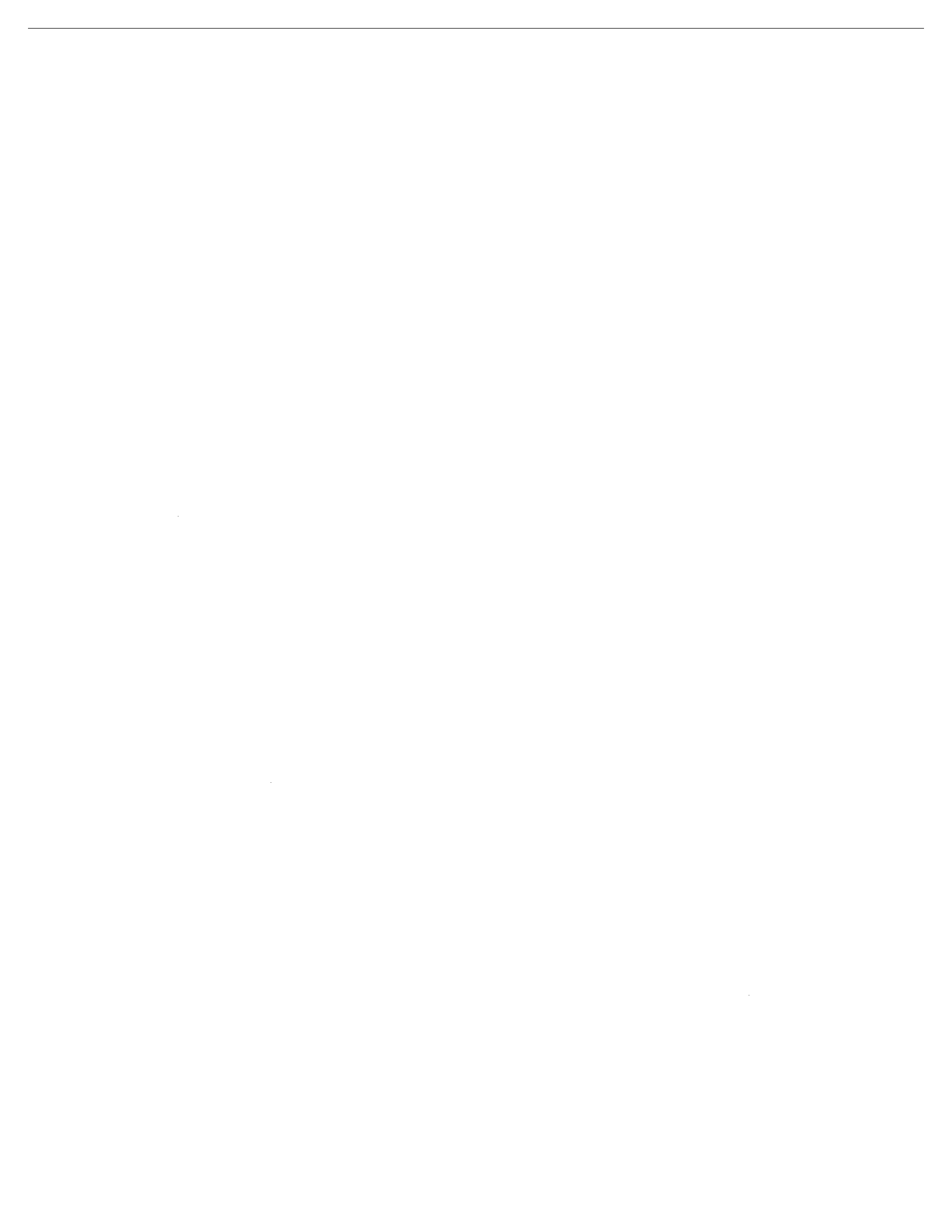

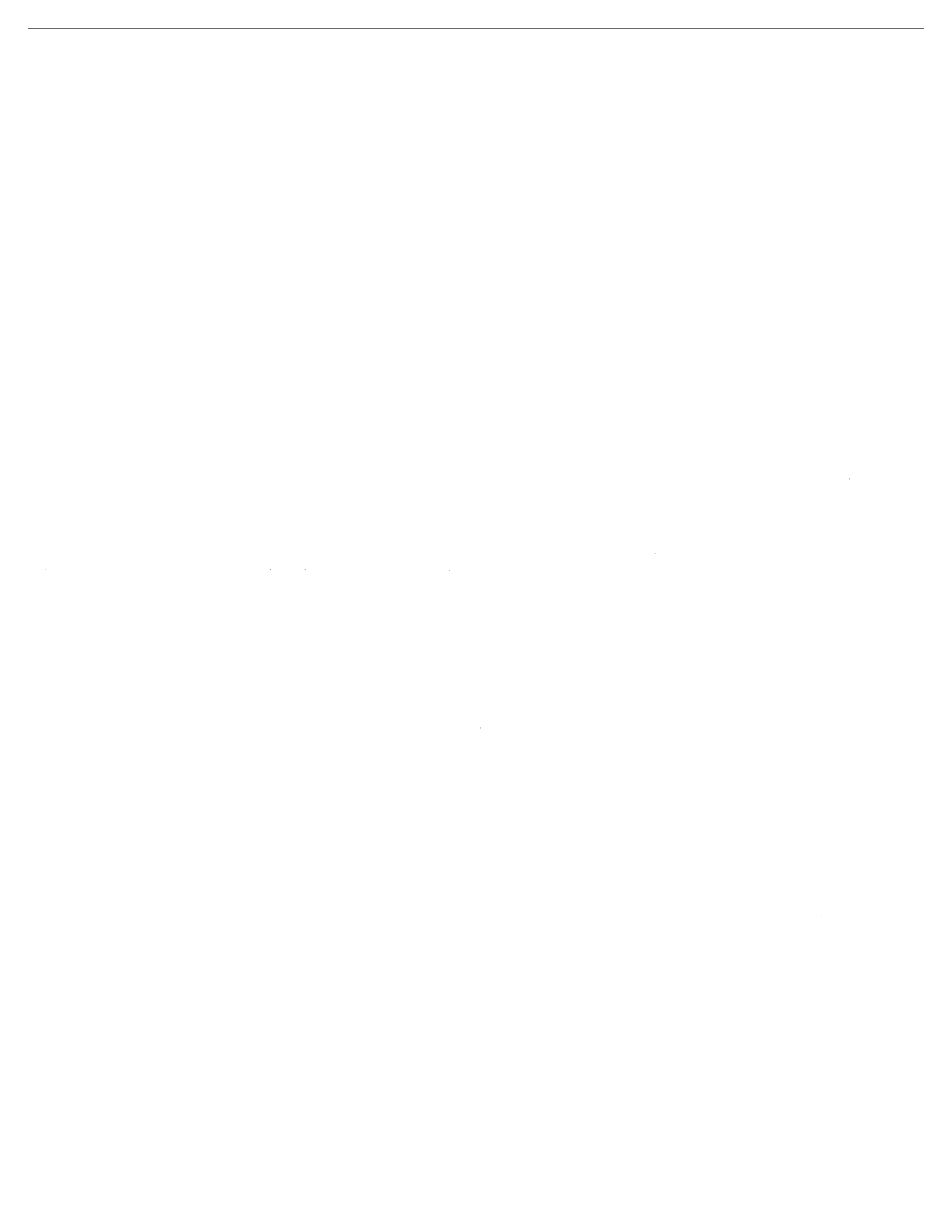

CLEC Facilities-Based Access Line Estimation Methodology

In order to give an accurate assessment of the level of competition in the wireline telecommunications markets that BellSouth operates in, Interconnection Services issues the monthly Local Competition Report. This report shows various categories of information reflecting the current level of competitive activity of CLECs for each of the nine states the company provides local access service. The number of total access lines is estimated for each state and this total is composed of CLECs' resold BellSouth lines and their own facilities-based lines. The facilities-based access line estimate is the summation of the business and residence line estimates. Both of these facilities-based estimates are calculated using data from BellSouth billing systems records and therefore are conservative in nature since they usually do not capture customers of CLECs who obtain their access lines directly from a CLEC utilizing only the CLECs facilities.

Facilities-based Business Access Lines

The facilities-based business access lines estimate uses four sources of information for each CLEC in each state: unbundled network loops (UNLs), interconnection trunks (both CLEC to BST and BST to CLEC), unbundled network business combinations (UNE business combos), and E911 listings. The greatest of these four sources of information is used as the estimate with an adjustment to three of the four sources to create a business and residence line split. UNEs, interconnection trunks and E911 listings are a combined business and residence number and therefore must be adjusted to reflect the split between business and residence lines. This split is calculated by taking the greater of residence directory listings and residence ported numbers (both interim and permanent) and subtracting that from the number UNEs, interconnection trunks or E911 listings. The end result of this split adjustment produces both the business and the residence CLEC facilities-based estimates. There is no need to make this adjustment for UNE business combos since they are by definition only business lines. It should be noted that one interconnection trunk is counted as one access line. This estimate is d

Facilities-based Residence Lines

The facilities-based residence access lines estimate uses two sources of information for each CLEC in each state: unbundled network residence combinations (UNE residence combos) and the residence split portion of UNEs, interconnection trunks or E911 listings. This residence split portion is only used as the residence line estimate when there are no UNE residence combos and when the business estimate relied on the business and residence split adjustment. This estimate is done by CLEC and summed up by state for the Local Competition Report.

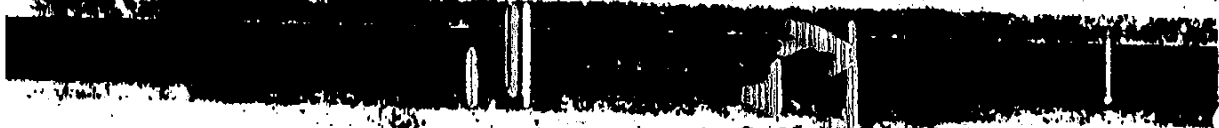

ORDER GRANTING CERTIFICATE OF
CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

On April 13, 1999, this matter came before the Tennessee Regulatory Authority ("Authority"), upon the Application of ALEC, Inc. ("ALEC") for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Provide Intrastate Telecommunications Services (the "Application"). The Application was made pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-201 et seq.

LEGAL STANDARD FOR GRANTING CCN

ALEC's Application was considered in light of the criteria for granting a certificate of public convenience and necessity ("CCN") as set forth in applicable statutes. Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-201 provides, in part:

(a) No public utility shall establish or begin the construction of, or operate any line, plant, or system, or route in or into a municipality or other territory already receiving a like service from another public utility, or establish service therein, without first having obtained from the authority, after written application and hearing, a certificate that the present or future public convenience and necessity require or will require such construction, establishment, and operation, and no person or corporation not at the time a public utility shall commence the construction of any plant, line, system or route to be operated as a public utility, or the operation of which would constitute the same, or the owner or operator thereof, a public utility as defined by law, without having first obtained, in like manner, a similar certificate . . .

* * *

(c) After notice to the incumbent local exchange telephone company and other interested parties and following a hearing, the authority shall grant a certificate of convenience and necessity to a competing telecommunications service provider if after examining the evidence presented, the authority finds:

(1) The applicant has demonstrated that it will adhere to all applicable commission policies, rules and orders; and

(2) The applicant possesses sufficient managerial, financial, and technical abilities to provide the applied for services.

An authority order, including appropriate findings of fact and conclusions of law, denying or approving, with or without modification, an application for certification of a competing telecommunications service provider shall be entered no more than sixty (60) days from the filing of the application.

(d) Subsection (c) is not applicable to areas served by an incumbent local exchange telephone company with fewer than 100,000 total access lines in this state unless such company voluntarily enters into an interconnection agreement with a competing telecommunications service provider or unless such incumbent local exchange telephone company applies for a certificate to provide telecommunications services in an area outside its service area existing on June 6, 1995.

In addition, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-5-212, competing telecommunications providers are required to file with the Authority (1) a plan containing the provider's plan for purchasing goods and services from small and minority-owned telecommunications businesses; and (2) information on programs that might provide technical assistance to such businesses.

INTERVENORS

Public notice of the hearing in this matter was made by the Authority's Executive Secretary, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-204. No interested persons sought intervention prior to hearing.

ALEC'S HEARING

ALEC's Application was uncontested. At the hearing held on April 13, 1999, ALEC was represented by John Knox Walkup and Sharon O. Jacobs of Wyatt, Tarrant & Combs, 1500 Nashville City Center, 511 Union Street, Nashville, Tennessee 37219-1750. In addition, Jeffrey T. Carneal, Vice President of ALEC, Inc. presented testimony and was subject to examination by the Authority's Directors. Upon ALEC's conclusion of the proof in its case, the Authority granted ALEC's Application based upon the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

I. APPLICANT'S QUALIFICATIONS

1. ALEC is a closely held corporation, organized on April 28, 1997 under the laws of the State of Kentucky. ALEC is authorized to transact business in Tennessee.

~~2. The complete street address of ALEC's principal place of business is 1301~~
Broadway, Paducah, Kentucky 42001. The phone number is (502) 442-5363 and fax number is (502) 442-2685. ALEC's counsel are John Knox Walkup and Sharon O. Jacobs of Wyatt, Tarrant & Combs, 1500 Nashville City Center, 511 Union Street, Nashville, Tennessee 37219.

3. The Application and supporting documentary information existing in the record indicate that ALEC has the requisite technical and managerial qualifications necessary to provide facilities-based and resold local exchange, exchange access and interexchange telecommunication services throughout State of Tennessee. Specifically, ALEC's management and technical teams have extensive expertise in the information, computing and telecommunications industries.

4. ALEC has the necessary capital and financial capability to provide the services it proposes to offer.

5. ALEC has represented that it will adhere to all applicable policies, rules and orders of the Authority.

II. PROPOSED SERVICES

1. In addition to providing business customers with local exchange telecommunication services, ALEC intends to compete in the exchange access and interexchange markets throughout the State of Tennessee. ALEC plans to provide service in the existing service areas of BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc.; nevertheless, ALEC seeks statewide authority so that it may expand into other service areas as market conditions warrant. Initially, ALEC plans to install switches in Nashville and/or Memphis and will operate as a switch-based reseller, and then over the next five years it will expand into other markets in Tennessee.

2. Except as may be authorized by law, ALEC does not intend to serve any areas currently being served by an incumbent local telephone company with fewer than 100,000 total access lines where local exchange competition is prohibited pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-4-201(d).

III. PERMITTING COMPETITION TO SERVE THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY

Upon a review of the Application and the record in this matter, the Authority finds that approval of ALEC's application would inure to the benefit of the present and future public convenience by permitting competition in the telecommunications services markets within the State and by fostering the development of an efficient technologically advanced statewide system of telecommunications services.

IV. SMALL AND MINORITY-OWNED TELECOMMUNICATIONS BUSINESS PARTICIPATION PLAN & BUSINESS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

1. Pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-5-212 and the Authority's Rules, ALEC has filed a satisfactory small and minority-owned telecommunications business participation plan.

2. ALEC has acknowledged its obligation to contribute to the funding of the small and minority-owned telecommunications business assistance program, as set forth in Tenn. Code Ann. § 65-5-213.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. The Application of ALEC as applied for is approved;
2. Any party aggrieved with the Authority's decision in this matter has the right to judicial review by filing a Petition for Review in the Tennessee Court of Appeals, Middle Section, within sixty (60) days from and after the date of this Order.

It also enhances KIH's ability to offer facilities-based DSL service. DSL -- short for Digital Subscriber Line -- is a technology that turns a standard phone line into a high-speed Internet pipeline, with connections up to 100 times faster than conventional dial-up modems.

At the heart of the new facility is a Nortel DMS 200 telephony switch with the capacity to handle more than 125,000 calls per day, fed by three fully redundant DS3 with 45 mbps capacity and connected to a 270 mbps upstream Asynchronous Transfer Mode (ATM) backbone. Other equipment includes a Lucent CBX500 switch to process ATM functions and a Cisco Core Backbone Router, with a Layer 3 Big Iron Ethernet Switch with Gigabit Ethernet on an internal network.

The facility is equipped with a state-of-the-art fire protection system and supported by a back-up generator with 24 hours of fuel and enough power to light up several square blocks of Downtown Lexington.

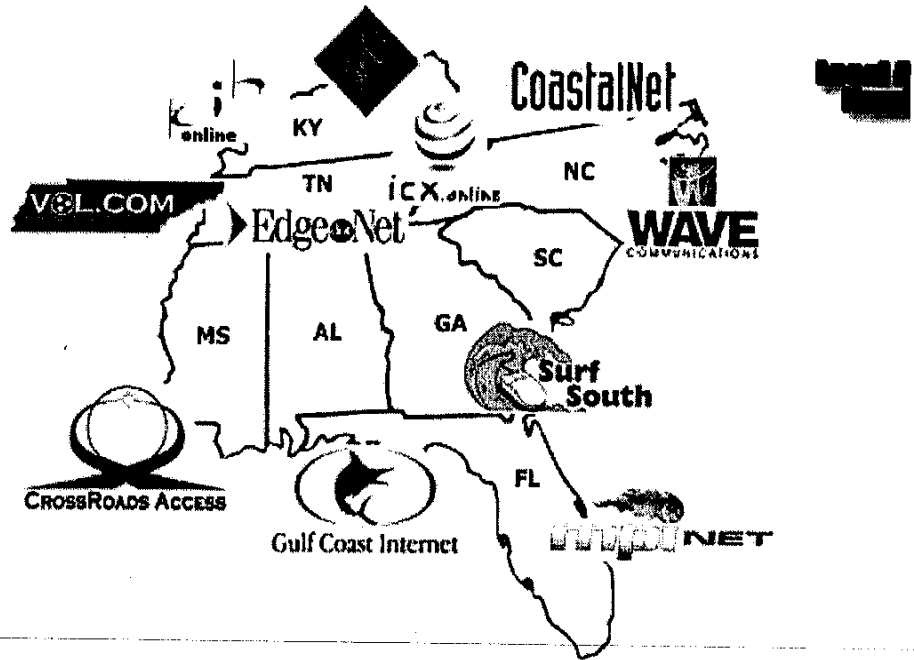

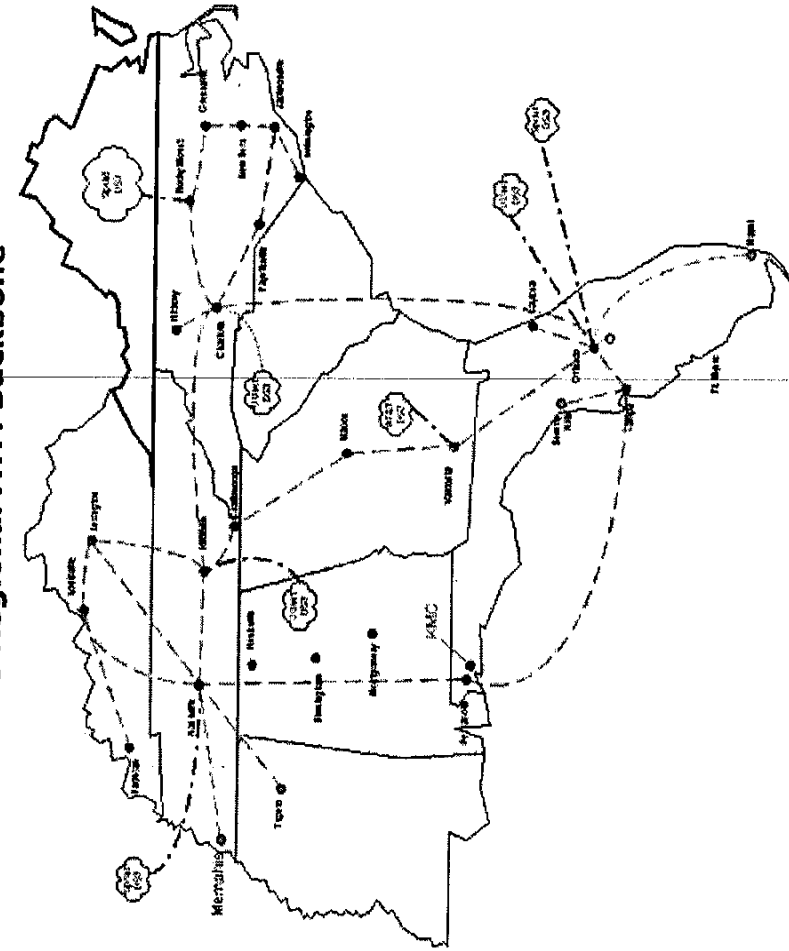

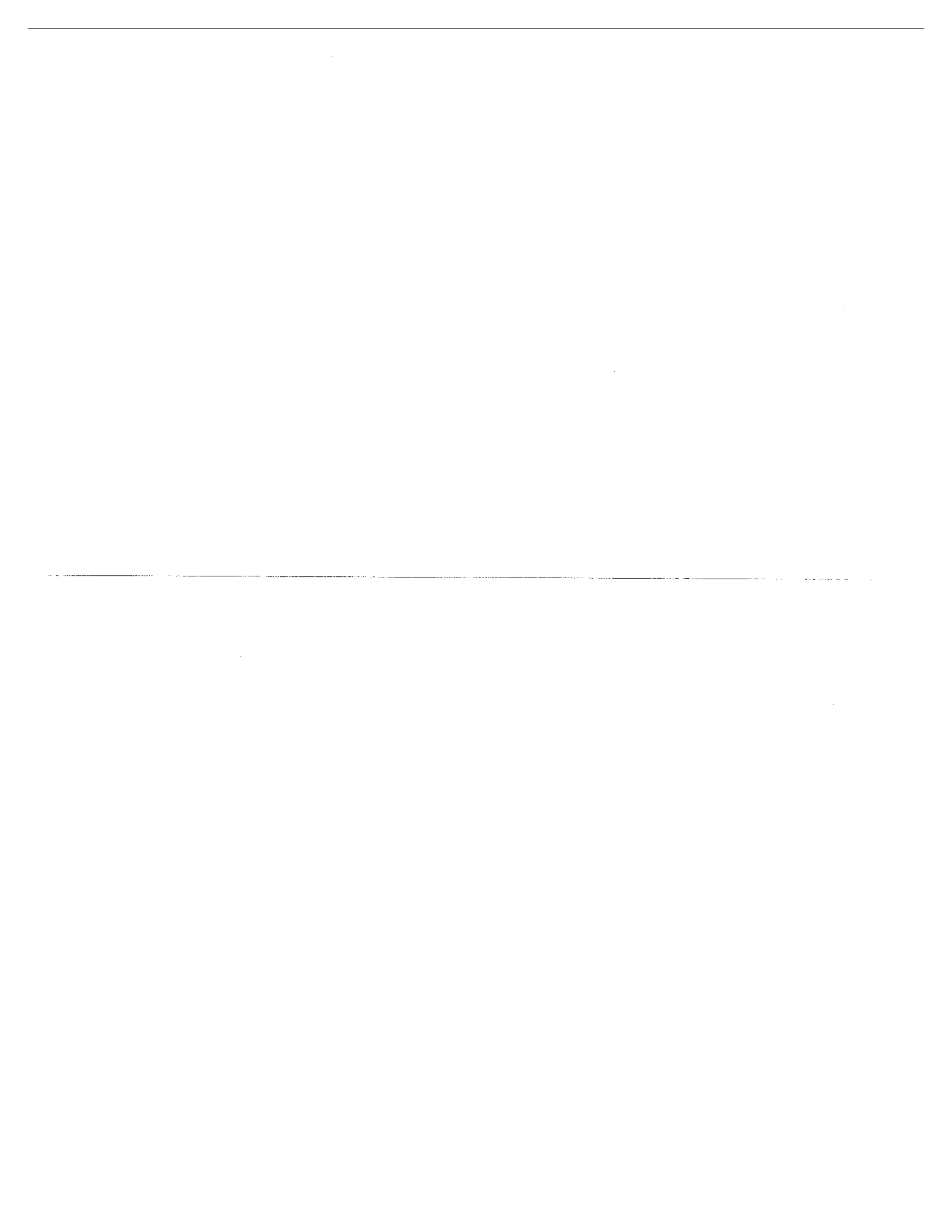

Birch Telecom Reports Operating Results for 1st Quarter 2001

KANSAS CITY, Mo., May 15 /PRNewswire/ -- Birch Telecom, Inc. today reported unaudited results for the quarter ended March 31, 2001.

Revenue for the first quarter increased to \$38.4 from \$36.1 million for the fourth quarter 2000, and from \$23.8 million for the first quarter 2000. For the first quarter, earnings before interest, taxes, depreciation and amortization (EBITDA) was a \$30.0 million loss, down from a \$32.7 million loss for the fourth quarter 2000 and up from a first quarter 2000 loss of \$14.7 million.

Gross margins increased to \$13.6 million (35.5% of revenue) for the first quarter 2001 compared to \$13.2 million (36.7% of revenue) for the fourth quarter ended 2000. Gross margins were also up from the \$6.5 million (27.2% of revenue) reported in the first quarter 2000.

Access lines increased 70.8% to 249,742 at March 31, 2001 from 146,241 at March 31, 2000 and a 7.8% increase from 231,625 lines at December 31, 2000. We have restated access lines, beginning in December 2000, to include data line equivalents at 64 Kbps per channel.

Since December 31, 2000, 4 additional markets turned EBITDA positive on a pre-overhead basis. In the first quarter of 2001, the 21 EBITDA positive markets generated \$36.7 million in revenue, gross margins of 35.2% and EBITDA of \$5.0 million, representing 13.7% of revenue. At December 31, 2000, there were 17 EBITDA positive markets that generated \$30.7 million in revenue, gross margins of 38.5% and EBITDA of \$3.8 million, representing 12.5% of revenue.

"Against a backdrop of general difficulty in the industry, Birch was able to continue its strong momentum through the first quarter with a highly successful launch of new markets in BellSouth and development of its own DSL capability, in preparation for an extensive 11 market launch. With this record of progress, Birch was able to secure a \$105 million equity commitment to fully fund its business plan," stated David Scott, President and CEO of Birch.

Recent Events

Birch officially launched local and long distance service in the southern U.S. by employing marketing efforts in Birmingham, Mobile and Montgomery, Alabama; Atlanta and Augusta, Georgia; and Chattanooga, Memphis, Nashville and Knoxville, Tennessee. Birch currently serves 32 markets with 305 sales representatives. Market expansion into the BellSouth territory should be completed by the end of the second quarter 2001 and will include a total of 14 markets.

During the first quarter 2001, the company successfully converted all its existing resale digital subscriber lines (DSL) to its own network. Birch identified the risk for potential loss of service for its resale customers being serviced through a wholesale arrangement with a DSL provider who recently filed for bankruptcy. Birch was able to execute a plan for more expedient conversion of its customers. Despite time constraints, nearly all of Birch's customers were converted before the wholesale provider ceased to provide service.

In a move to contain costs and improve earnings performance, Birch has

implemented a number of cost savings initiatives during the first quarter 2001. These initiatives included the severance of 308 employees in February 2001. As a result of this reduction in workforce, Birch incurred non-recurring expenses during the first quarter 2001, which included \$3.6 million of severance pay and \$600,000 related to loss on disposition of certain leasehold improvements abandoned in conjunction with the reduction in workforce. Despite these non-recurring charges, Birch has managed to improve EBITDA losses by \$2.7 million compared to fourth quarter 2000.

On March 30, 2001 Birch announced that its majority stockholder, an affiliate of private investment firm Kohlberg Kravis Roberts & Co., agreed to purchase up to \$105 million of a new issue of convertible preferred stock. Birch received the first part of the investment, \$75 million, on this date and will receive up to an additional \$30 million in equity by July 31, 2001, subject to customary closing conditions. Concurrent with this transaction, certain terms and covenants under Birch's senior credit facility were amended. Lehman Brothers served as exclusive financial advisor to Birch on this transaction.

2001 Guidance

With Birch's recent actions to contain costs and improve earnings performance, the investment of \$105 million in equity is expected to fully fund the company's current business plan.

We expect that local service, long distance service, Internet/data and customer premises equipment sales will continue to be the principal components of our revenue. However, as was the case during 1999 and 2000, we do not expect equipment sales to increase as a percentage of total revenue, and we expect minimal long distance growth due to increased competition. Over the long term, we intend to make Internet/data services a greater percentage of total revenue with the deployment of our DSL service now offered in select markets. Additionally, we expect to see some revenue growth from service offerings to residential customers and large-sized businesses over the next few years. In recent months, we have been experiencing decreases in access revenue due to rate reductions caused by competitive pricing pressures. We cannot predict whether this trend will continue and although access revenue was \$6.4 million in 2000, it comprises only 5% of our total revenue.

We expect that gross margins for local service will increase over time as we continue to add service using the unbundled network elements platform. Moreover, we anticipate that the incumbents' costs will decrease with technology improvements and operating efficiencies and that these savings are passed down to us. Even though we expect long distance prices to decline, we do not expect margins to decrease given the declines we have been experiencing in our network costs.

If we increase our Internet/data revenue stream as we intend, margins should begin to increase, especially in markets where we own our own DSL and ATM facilities. We expect customer premises equipment margins to remain constant.

We expect to continue to focus on increasing our customer base and geographic coverage. However, we expect selling, general and administrative expenses will remain relatively flat, becoming a smaller percentage of our revenue in the near term, as we realize operating efficiencies.

Our capital asset purchase levels will decline sharply from 2000 as a result of the completion of our DSL buildout and recent back office improvements. We currently estimate that the cash required to fund capital expenditures will be approximately \$15 - \$25 million for 2001, consisting primarily of maintenance of our operations support systems and automated back office systems, and the purchase, installation and expansion of switches, collocations and transmission equipment for our local and data networks to support growing demand.

Dear Ms. Salas:

When we met with officials of the Common Carrier Bureau April 24, 2001, we were asked to provide additional information about approaches and options for the "carve-out" of unbundled local switching (ULS). As we have noted previously in the record, and as we reiterated in our meeting on April 24, McLeodUSA's preference would be first, to eliminate any ULS restrictions, so as to make that element universally available. While we strongly believe that the best route would be to simply continue the status quo pending the next general review of UNEs, we believe that other options that would substantially narrow the availability of ULS are under active consideration. In that context, we believe that the record has been enriched by a number of thoughtful and viable proposals such as that proposed by Birch Telecom in its letter of January 17, 2001, which ensures a fair and workable application of the "impairment" test in the context of the availability of ULS. While we are quite comfortable that such proposals would effect a workable solution, we are responding to the CCB's request for additional input to the record that would measure impairment at a more granular level. Specifically, we are responding to the CCB's inquiries regarding a different route to identifying a "carve out" for ULS, by focusing on the status of individual central offices (COs). This letter will further explain a potential rationale for such a CO-based focus.

The typical method by which a competitive carrier provides switching to its own customers is by installing collocations in ILEC COs, and then cross-connecting unbundled loops to the collocation so that local dialtone can be provided by the competitive carrier's switch. Thus, in providing switching to customers served by a particular ILEC CO, a competitive carrier incurs fixed costs associated with both the installation of a switch, and with establishing a collocation. The costs of the switch may

be spread over customers served by multiple collocations in a geographic area; but the costs of the collocation are CO-specific, and will be incurred in each CO.

Thus, in order to self-provision switching, a competitor will incur fixed costs per "market" for a switch, and fixed costs per CO for each individual CO within the market. Whether self-provisioning of switching is possible depends in large part upon the following factors for each CO:

- a. Number of lines served by the CO
- b. Expected market penetration in the CO
- c. Expected customer mix in the CO
- d. Expected margins for each type of customer served from the CO
- e. Collocation costs
- f. Switching costs attributable to customers in the CO
- g. Transaction costs with the incumbent for provisioning the loops which the switching would serve

Consideration of these factors determines whether a collocation and self-provisioning of switching, is possible.¹ Because these factors can vary on a CO-by-CO basis, their application to an analysis of whether self-provisioning of switching is possible should also be based on conditions in individual COs.

Because of this variance in conditions between COs, McLeodUSA believes that the best evidence of whether ULS is necessary in a given CO is whether competitive carriers are generally self-provisioning switching in the CO. A lack of widespread self-provisioning of such switching is a clear indication that a carrier would be impaired in its ability to provide service in the absence of such switching. Conversely, a widespread use of self-provisioned switching would indicate a lack of such impairment..

For such a test to truly promote the development of local exchange competition, it should be applied in a manner that (in cases of doubt) tends to make ULS more, rather than less, available. McLeodUSA would propose that when at least 40% of the physical loops² served from a central office receive local dialtone from a switch other than the ILEC's switch, it might be reasonable to question the necessity of ULS (and therefore to restrict the availability of ULS) in that central office. Because of the wide disparity between sizes and customer mix between various COs, this count of physical loops might

¹ Current pricing of EELs makes them generally unusable for providing voice-grade service to end users.

² It is important that this test be applied in terms of physical loops rather than lines or line-equivalents, because it is physical loops which are purchased as UNEs by competitors. Additionally, the use of physical loops results in a de facto control for factors related to customer characteristics, such as the potential ability to economically self-provision switching for customers below the DS-1 level.

be supplemented with an additional test, to guard against the possibility that a competitor served a single customer with a high percentage of the loops in the CO.³

To give a measure of certainty to both suppliers and providers of ULS, this would be measured at a given point in time, with the results applied until the next interval for review of all UNEs had occurred. To the extent ULS becomes restricted in a CO where it had previously been available, purchasers of ULS should either be allowed to continue their existing purchases, or should be allowed to move to a different service platform with all nonrecurring charges for such a conversion being waived.

The CO-by-CO test above has an advantage over tests using a broader geographic scope to measure competitive switching alternatives, because it more closely reflects the actual availability of alternatives to ULS within a discrete geographic area. Such a test is also "self-correcting" for factors such as changes in capital markets, since the ability of competitive companies to deploy switches is automatically reflected in the market results.⁴

At the same time, the information necessary to apply this test is relatively available. ILECs know how many physical loops are served by a central office, and how many unbundled loops without unbundled switch ports are purchased in the CO. The calculation of the percentage would essentially be the number of unbundled loops without switch ports divided by the total number of working physical loops in the central office.

While some might argue that this process is biased because the mere availability of ULS will reduce the deployment of alternative switching (and therefore tend to increase the availability of ULS), such an argument would be incorrect. The Commission's rules, which specify a TELRIC standard for the pricing of network elements, will prevent such a situation. Because TELRIC ULS costs track the costs of deploying new switching by a competitive provider, the decision as to whether to deploy, or not to deploy, switching will be unaffected by the availability of ULS (since the carrier's per-port costs will be the same in either case). Obviously, the specific implementation of the TELRIC rules by individual states may affect this result at the margin, but not to an extent sufficient to affect the basic "build vs. buy" decision. In fact, the advantages to a company of owning its own network facilities, coupled with the advantages of reduced interactions with the incumbent carrier, almost certainly bias any decision toward "build" and away from "buy," even if ULS is available. Thus, the Commission need not be concerned about discouraging the deployment of switching facilities. McLeodUSA believes that those facilities will be deployed as quickly as the capital markets will allow,

³ Such an additional test could center either on a percentage of customers ("competitors provide dialtone to at least "x"% of the customers in the CO"), or on the number of competitors providing dialtone for lines in the CO.

⁴ McLeodUSA believes that, given current constriction in capital markets, relatively few new switch installations are currently being planned.

even if ULS is widely available.⁵ The mechanism discussed in this letter for determining ULS availability will automatically take this phenomenon into account.

In conclusion, determining whether a competitive carrier would be impaired by the absence of ULS in a given CO can be determined in a straightforward manner by examining the extent to which other carriers are providing their own local switching. If a substantial percentage (McLeodUSA suggests 40%) of the physical loops in a CO are receiving local dialtone from a switch other than the incumbent's provider's switch, then self-provisioning would seem to be a viable option and a lack of ULS could be deemed not to "impair" the competitor in the CO. Smaller percentages would indicate inadequate alternatives, warranting a conclusion that competitors would be impaired by the lack of ULS.

We will be available to the Commission and its staff to discuss these ideas further as requested.
