O R D E R

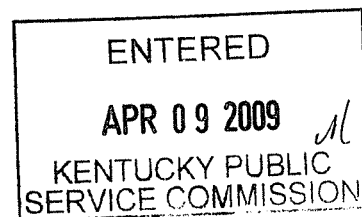
On April 3, 2009, Competitive Carriers of the South, Inc. ("CompSouth") moved for a one-week extension of time to file its reply in support of its objection to BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Kentucky's ("AT&T Kentucky") Force Majeure declaration of February 11, 2009. On March 11, 2009, the Commission issued a procedural schedule in this matter, wherein replies were to be filed by April 3, 2009. In support of its motion, CompSouth states that the parties are currently engaged in discussions and possible settlement negotiations related to the Force Majeure declaration. In its motion, CompSouth stated that the motion is not made for the purpose of delay and that AT&T Kentucky has agreed to CompSouth's request for a one-week extension.

Having reviewed the pleading and the arguments contained therein, the Commission finds that the motion for an extension of time shall be granted.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that

1. CompSouth's motion for extension of time is granted.
2. CompSouth shall have until April 10, 2009 to submit a reply in support of its objection to AT&T Kentucky's February 11, 2009 declaration of a Force Majeure Event.
