ORDER

On April 3, 2009, Competitive Carriers of the South, Inc. ("CompSouth") moved for a one-week extension of time to file its reply in support of its objection to BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a AT&T Kentucky's ("AT&T Kentucky") Force Majeure declaration of February 11, 2009. On March 11, 2009, the Commission issued a procedural schedule in this matter, wherein replies were to be filed by April 3, 2009.
