ORDER

On July 22, 2002, the Commission established this case to monitor the compliance of Kentucky-American Water Company, American Water Works Company, RWE Aktiengesellschaft and Thames Water Aqua Holdings GmbH with the provisions of the Commission's Orders of May 30, 2002 and of July 10, 2002 in Case No. 2002-00018.¹ We subsequently also used this case to monitor compliance with our Orders in Case No. 2002-00317.²

Given the lack of activity in this proceeding for the last three years and finding no benefit to continuing this case on the Commission's docket, we find that this case

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. This case is closed and removed from the Commission's docket.
