LOGAN TELEPHONE COOPERATIVE'S RESPONSE TO DATA REQUEST

On December 19, 2002 the Kentucky Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued Administrative Case No. 2002-00456 for the purpose of examining the use of contract service agreements ("CSAs") by telecommunication in Kentucky. In issuing Case No. 2002-00456 the Commission included a number of questions that interested parties were to address. Logan Telephone Cooperative, Inc. ("Logan") is now responding to the questions posed by the Commission.

- 1. Each telecommunications carrier named in the service list hereto shall respond to the information requested in Appendix C hereto no later than February 5, 2003 or, in the alternative, shall file with the Commission a statement that it does not wish to participate in this proceeding, together with a full explanation therefor.
- 1. Logan currently has no CSAs or policies regarding CSAs, and is following the company's tariffed rates in all matters. We do not anticipate entering into any new CSAs in the near future.
- 2. Each telecommunications carrier named in the service list hereto shall comply with the procedural schedule in Appendix B hereto or, in the alternative, shall file with the Commission a statement that it does not wish to participate in this proceeding.
- 2. Having no CSAs or plans to enter into new CSAs in the future, Logan respectfully requests to be released from participation in this proceeding and seeks to avoid the administrative, legal and regulatory costs of participating in this docket.
