## WITHDRAWAL OF INTERVENTION

On September 29, 2003 the Competitive Carriers of the South, Inc. ("CompSouth") requested intervention in the above-captioned proceeding. CompSouth's request stated its tentative position not to request that the Commission petition the FCC for a waiver of the FCC's "no impairment" finding with regard to local circuit switching for enterprise customers. CompSouth subsequently determined not to make such a request. Neither CompSouth nor any of its members are seeking any relief in this proceeding. Accordingly, CompSouth has determined to withdraw from this proceeding. <sup>1</sup>
