O R D E R

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") and SouthEast Telephone, Inc. ("SouthEast") have moved for extensions of time in this proceeding. BellSouth's responses to data requests were due on November 10, 2003. BellSouth asks for an extension to November 21, 2003. SouthEast's prefiled testimony was due November 14, 2003. It asks for an extension until 3 days after the receipt of BellSouth's responses. The Commission finds that the motion of BellSouth should be granted and the motion of SouthEast should be granted to the extent that its prefiled testimony is now due November 21, 2003. As time is of the essence, further delays by any party will not be allowed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Responses to data requests of all parties shall be filed no later than November 21, 2003.
2. Prefiled testimony of SouthEast and any other party shall be due no later than November 21, 2003.
