Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company ("CBT") hereby advises BellSouth
Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") that it does not intend to respond to the individual
interrogatories and request for production of documents as set forth in BellSouth's Second Set of
Interrogatories and Second Request for Production of Documents served November 24, 2003.
CBT notes that the interrogatories and requests for production of documents appear to be
intended for competitive local exchange carriers and providers of wholesale telecommunications
facilities offering service within BellSouth's operating area. CBT points out that it does not
provide competitive local exchange service and has not deployed either loop or transport
facilities outside of its traditional operating area. In its capacity as an incumbent local exchange
carrier, however, CBT acknowledges that it provides transport and loop facilities within its
traditional operating area as a retail provider and on a wholesale basis. For these reasons, CBT
does not believe that the information sought from CBT with respect to its traditional operating
area is relevant to the Commission's impairment analysis with respect to BellSouth's operating
area.
