MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**


BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), by counsel, respectfully requests a short extension to file the discovery responses to MCI WorldCom Communications, Inc. ("MCI") and AT&T Communications of the South Central States, LLC ("AT&T") second set of discovery due today. Due to the voluminous nature of these materials and the expedited nature of the discovery schedule in this proceeding, BellSouth has found it necessary to make this request.

By Order dated November 4, 2003, the Commission entered an order setting out a procedural schedule in this case. Responses to discovery served November 24, 2003 are due December 15, 2003. BellSouth has worked diligently to gather the material to respond to the data requests and requests for production of documents of MCI and AT&T, but does not have all the information necessary to file responses today. Therefore, BellSouth

requests an extension of time to file its responses. This motion is not made for the purposes of delaying this proceeding.

Accordingly, BellSouth respectfully requests this short extension of time to respond to the second set of data requests of AT&T and MCI.
