O R D E R

On February 25, 2004, AT&T Communications of the South Central States, LLC ("AT&T") filed a motion to compel BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") to disclose specified information contained in BellSouth's business records concerning competitive local exchange carriers identified as self-providers of local switching to serve the mass market in the direct prefiled testimony of BellSouth's witness Pamela A. Tipton.

The information requested by AT&T is relevant to this proceeding and, accordingly, should be provided by BellSouth to AT&T. The parties hereto have entered into a confidentiality agreement, and the requested information should be made available pursuant to such protective agreement within 3 business days from the date of this Order. BellSouth has indicated it has no objection.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that BellSouth shall respond to AT&T's interrogatories referenced herein within 3 business days of the date of this Order.
