


NOTICE OF INTERVENTION

Comes now SouthEast Telephone, Inc. ("SouthEast"), by and through counsel, and hereby notifies the Commission of its intent to intervene as a party in this case. In support of this Petition, SouthEast states as follows:

1. On October 2, 2003, the Commission issued an Order regarding the Triennial Review by the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"); specially regarding that portion of the Triennial Review Order that deals with unbundling requirements for individual network elements.
