

Conservation Tips

- 1. Is it possible your toilet has a secret leak? You can test it by putting 10 drops of food coloring in the tank. Don't flush for 15 minutes. If the colored water shows up in the bowl, the tank is leaking.
- 2. Some people thoughtlessly flush away tissues and other bits of trash in the toilet. Using a wastebasket instead, will save all those gallons of water that otherwise go wastefully down the drain.
- 3. If you have an older model toilet, fill a plastic bag or container with water, seal it, and place it in your toilet tank to help decrease the amount of water you use each time you flush.
- 4. Have you ever heard of showering "The Navy Way"? Because fresh water is relatively scarce on ships, sailors were taught to just get wet, and then turn off the shower while soaping and scrubbing, and turn it on again briefly to rinse off. It's a great water conservation technique.
- 5. Remember the "Rule of Five": Take five-minute showers and use no more than five inches of water in the tub.
- 6. You can use just one less gallon of water per shower by keeping the shower pressure lower or by making your showers a few seconds shorter.
- 7. Don't let the water run when you brush your teeth, when washing your face, or when shaving. Most of it will be wasted. Just take what you need and save the rest.
- 8. Water heaters often are set at 140 degrees. You can save energy by turning the temperature on you water heater down to 130 degrees. Don't go any lower because some harmful bacteria could survive.
- 9. Fill your dishwasher full because it will use the same amount of water for a normal cycle, whether it contains a full load of dishes or just a few items.
- 10. There's really no need to fully wash dishes before loading in the dishwasher. Just scrape off food scraps and rinse.
- 11. Stopper the sink when you wash dishes by hand; and when you're finished, turn on the garbage disposal as you pull the plug.
- 12. If your soap does not have phosphates, you may be able to recycle rinse water to give your plants a drink.
- 13. If you like to rinse off vegetables and fruits, stopper the sink instead of using running water, and you can recycle that water.
- 14. To determine which is more water efficient, washing dishes in an automatic dishwasher or doing them by hand in the sink by testing how many gallons a full sink basin holds compared with the 9.5 to 12 gallons dishwashing machines use during a regular cycle.
- 15. Instead of letting the water run in the sink when you want a cool drink, keep a jug or pitcher cooling in the refrigerator.
- 16. Check every faucet in the house for leaks. A single dripping faucet can waste far more water in a single day than one person needs for drinking in an entire week.
- 17. Check the water taps in your home to see if they all have aerators or spray taps. An aerator mixes air with the water, which not only cuts the flow but reduces splashing. The spray tap is similar, but also can swing from side to side like a tiny showerhead.
- 18. Select the appropriate water level for the size of your load of laundry. Most washers now offer preset water levels for small, medium, and large loads. Use full loads whenever possible.

- 19. Here's a two-for-one idea if you have a fish tank in the house. When you clean the tank, use the dirty water on your houseplants. It's rich in nitrogen and phosphorous, which gives you a nice fertilizer while you use the same water twice.
- 20. Know where your shut-off valve is. If emergency leak repairs are needed, quickly locating and shutting off your valve will prevent flooding and water waste.

How Much Can You Save?

The average person in Lexington uses 80-85 gallons per day. This increases to about 120-130 gallons per person per day in the summer. Although a lot of this is due to outside watering, some is due to bathing more frequently, doing laundry more frequently, letting the water run to a cooler temperature for drinking, etc.

Ways To Save Water

Activity	Amount of Water Saved
Eliminating one minute off your shower (or turning it off while you lather up).	3-7 gallons per person. (For a family of four, that is an average savings of 20 gallons per day!)
Tip: Use an oven timer to be sure you know when your time in the shower is up.	
Put some sand in the bottom of an empty 20 oz soda bottle, fill with water, screw lid on tightly, and slip in your toilet tank.	3-5 gallons of water per day. (For a family of our, this will save 3.5 gallons of water per day.)
Tip: If there is room for a liter bottle, it will save 5.5 gallons per day.	
Fill a small glass with water, dip your toothbrush in it to	2 gallons per day for a family of four.



- Shorten your shower time by one minute and save
 3-7 gallons per shower.

- Don't rinse dishes before putting them in the dishwasher. Scrape food off instead. You could save 2-5 gallons daily.
- Run only a full dishwasher. Two small loads use twice as much water as a full one.
- Wash fruits and vegetables in a pan and save the water for indoor plants.
- Don't-run tap water until cool for drinking. Keep water in the refrigerator. You could save 2-5 gallons a day.
- If you have a toilet that was installed before 1994 you can save up to 3 gallons a day by placing a water-filled plastic bottle or bag in the tank.
