

RATES

Establishment Charge:

A non-refundable charge of \$20 will be required whenever service is established for the first time by any applicant at the requested location. This charge only applies to the initial establishment of service at the requested location and does not apply to reestablishment or re-connections. (R14-2-403.D.1).

Establishment Charge (after hours):

A non-refundable charge of \$40 will be required whenever service is established for the first time by any applicant at the requested location. This charge only applies to the initial establishment of service at the requested location and does not apply to reestablishment or re-connections (R14-2-403.D.1). Reestablishment Charge:

Reconnection Charge:

If a customer makes a request of the Company to restore water service previously disconnected for non-payment of service, the Company is authorized to charge a service fee of \$30 for reconnection of service (R14-2-403.D.1).
