

By letter dated May 26, 2005, BellSouth so notified this Commission of its intent to withdraw the Kentucky-specific plan and continue with the Georgia plan, including any future modifications made by the Georgia Commission. By Order dated June 20, 2005, this Commission granted BellSouth's motion to withdraw its application for a Kentucky-specific performance plan and to continue to operate under the Georgia Performance Plan, as previously ordered.
