By Order dated March 10, 2005, the Commission directed the parties in this docket to inform it in writing by April 15, 2005, of the status of their negotiations as a result of Federal Communications Commission's (FCC's) issuance of the Triennial Review Remand Order (TRRO). Accordingly, undersigned counsel for Dialog Telecommunications, Inc. ("Dialog") provides this response.

On March 14, 2005, BellSouth sent a letter to Dialog requesting negotiations for changes of law related to the TRRO. Dialog and BellSouth are within the 90-day period established by their interconnection agreement for negotiating changes of law, and at this time, negotiations have not been completed. However, Dialog has reviewed proposed Attachment 2 to the agreement, and on April 13 provided comments and proposed revisions to BellSouth.

Dialog's negotiations with BellSouth are necessarily affected by the fact that Dialog has a pending request before the Commission to adopt, pursuant to Section 252(i), an agreement previously approved by the Commission. Moreover, Dialog has a pending formal complaint against BellSouth related to violations of the terms of the existing ICA. BellSouth has made certain proposals concerning possible settlement of that complaint, and Dialog awaits further correspondence related to a BellSouth settlement offer.
