Dear Ms. O'Donnell:

The Illinois Municipal Electric Agency (IMEA) and the Indiana Municipal Power Agency (IMPA) give notice that they intend to file a joint application for approval of their collective 25% ownership of the proposed Trimble County electric generating plant, which is being constructed by Louisville Gas & Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company. IMEA and IMPA collectively own 25% of the existing Trimble County Unit 1. Pursuant to their respective Trimble County Unit 1 Participation Agreements, they also have rights to participate in the development and ownership of the new project. While their portion of this project qualifies as a "merchant electricity generating facility" under KRS 278.700 ff, IMEA and IMPA are joint action agencies and will use their portion of this project to provide wholesale power to their respective member communities pursuant to long-term contracts.

The proposed project consists of a 750 MW boiler and associated steam turbine generator to be constructed by the Louisville Gas and Electric Company and the Kentucky Utilities Company, which is the subject of Case No. 2004-00507. The proposed plant will be constructed on the site of the existing LG&E Trimble County Station near Bedford, KY. The project is currently designed to include selective catalytic reduction, bag house, wet limestone scrubber, and a wet electrostatic precipitator for air quality control. The maximum height of the proposed project structures will be approximately 285 feet, less than the existing height of the structures on the site.


3. The project will be located near Bedford, in Trimble County. The street address of the location is U.S. Highway 1838; the latitude is 38° 35' 13" N and longitude 85° 25' 6" E.

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
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
