

NOTICE OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

On May 31, 2005, the Illinois Municipal Electric Agency (“IMEA”) and the Indiana Municipal Power Agency (“IMPA”) filed a joint application with the Board for approval of their partnership with Louisville Gas and Electric Company (“LG&E”) and Kentucky Utilities Company (“KU”) in a project to construct a 750 MW addition to the existing generating station in Trimble County, Kentucky. The IMEA and IMPA are also partners with LG&E in Unit 1 at the existing generating station. LG&E and KU currently have a pending application with the Public Service Commission for their share of the addition, Case No. 2004-00507.

While IMEA and IMPA were not required to seek approval for their share of the existing plant, the statutes creating the Board and assigning it duties now require Board approval for their share in the addition, which qualifies as a merchant plant under those

statutes. To ensure that all parties have an opportunity to participate fully in this proceeding, the Board issues the attached procedural schedule.
