Clark Energy filed on June 14, 2005 an Application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to replace our existing Frenchburg, KY branch office with a new facility. Annual recurring expenses for the proposed Frenchburg branch office are anticipated to be about \$51,160 for debt expense, property tax, insurance, and related expenses. Other expenses for routine upkeep and maintenance of lawns, landscaping, and the parking lot are small incidental expenses.
