ATTORNEY GENERAL'S MOTION FOR ABEYANCE OF COMMISSION STAFF'S FIRST SET OF INFORMATION REQUESTS TO THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

The Attorney General, by and through counsel, moves the Commission for an Order suspending the deadline in the 9 March 2009 Order of procedure that requires the Attorney General to respond to the Commission's Staff's First Set of Information Requests on or before 23 March 2009. WHEREFORE, the Attorney General respectfully moves this Commission to hold in abeyance the deadline for the OAG's response to the Staff's first data request to the Attorney General.
