
Dear Mr. Ingram:

The Public Service Commission has received the Petition for Confidential Treatment you filed on January 8, 2009 on behalf of Kentucky American Water to protect certain information filed with the Commission as confidential under Section 7 of 807 KAR 5:001 and KRS 61.870 et. seq. The information you seek to have treated as confidential is identified as certain information filed in Kentucky American Water's Responses to Item Nos. 12 and 58 of the Commission's 2nd Information Requests and Item No. 17 of Lexington Fayette Urban County Government's 1st Information Requests. Your justification for having the Commission handle this material as confidential is that the information is confidential and proprietary information and contains employee incentive compensation plans and dividend policy; and fire hydrant maintenance.

Based on a review of the information and pursuant to KRS 61.878 and 807 KAR 5:001, section 7, the Commission has determined that the information you seek to keep confidential is of a proprietary nature, which if publicly disclosed would permit an unfair commercial advantage to your client's competitors. Therefore, the information requested to be treated as confidential meets the criteria for confidential protection and will be maintained as a nonpublic part of the Commission's file in this case. The procedure for usage of confidential materials during formal proceedings may be found at Section 7(8) of 807 KAR 5:001.

If the information becomes publically available or no longer warrants confidential treatment, Kentucky American Water is required by Section 8(9)(a) of 807 KAR 5:001 to inform the Commission so that the information may be placed in the public record.
