**MOTION OF HENDERSON MUNICIPAL POWER & LIGHT
FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE DATA REQUESTS**

Comes Henderson Municipal Power & Light (hereinafter referred to as "HMP&L"), by counsel, and moves the Kentucky State Board on Electric Generation and Transmission Siting (hereinafter "Siting Board"), pursuant to KRS Chapter 278, 807 KAR 5:110, and all other applicable law, for an extension of time to file data requests upon the Applicant. In support of its Motion, HMP&L states as follows:

1. That currently HMP&L has not been granted intervention status herein by the Siting Board. The current deadline to file data requests is August 23, 2010.
2. That HMP&L has been advised that the Applicant is in the process of filing an amended application which will significantly change the location of the proposed transmission line which is the subject of this Application. Such a modification may impact HMP&L's data requests.
3. That given the status of the pending matter, HMP&L requests that it be granted three business days after the entry of an order granting its Motion to Intervene to

file data requests. Further, since this extension will impact the time of response, HMP&L requests that the Applicant be granted a period of no longer than seven days from the date of filing of the data requests to respond thereto.

4. That the granting of this Motion will not unduly interfere with the process and will provide for complete participation by the movant, HMP&L, and will further assist the Board in a more complete evaluation of the Application.

WHEREFORE, Henderson Municipal Power & Light moves that it be granted an extension of time of three of business days after the entry of an order granting its Motion to Intervene to file data requests addressed to the Applicant. Further, HMP&L requests that the Applicant be granted a reasonable time, not to exceed seven days from the date of filing of the data requests to respond thereto.


