Atmos Kentucky	Any customer expecting to use at least 9000 Mcf annually
Citizens Gas Indiana	No Volumetric Threshold for any single-metered commercial customer
Columbia Gas of Kentucky	Customers using more than 25,000 Mcf annually; Customers under 25,000 Mcf can still participate in Columbia's Choice Program
Columbia Gas of Ohio	Customers using more than 6,000 Mcf per year; Customers under 6,000 Mcf can still participate in Columbia's Choice Program
Dominion East Ohio	No Volumetric Threshold for Non-Residential Customers
Duke Kentucky	Any Customer using more than 2,000 Mcf per year
Duke Ohio	No Volumetric Threshold for Non-Residential Customers
Ohio Valley Gas Corporation	Any Customer using at least 10,000 Dth annually*
Vectren North Indiana	Customers using at least 5,000 Dth annually*
Vectren South Indiana	Customers using at least 5,000 Dth annually*
Vectren Ohio	Customers using at least 5,000 Dth annually; customers below 5,000 Dth can participate in Vectren Ohio's Choice Program

\*Note: any customer deemed to be a school can take transportation service at any usage level.

In regards to Staff’s request for the “rate for each service,” Hess has not reviewed the LDC tariffs to discern the rates available for gas transportation customers. For many LDCs, gas transportation customers can choose among multiple rate classes offered by the LDC for distribution service. Hess only provides supply-related services to its gas transportation customers and does not provide distribution services, which is provided by their respective LDC.
