On July 13, 2012, Louisville Gas and Electric Company's ("LG&E" or "Company") filed initial responses to Question Nos. 43, 44, and 57 of the Commission Staff's First Request for Information dated June 15, 2012 in the above reference matter. These data requests require LG&E to periodically update the information provided in the initial data responses. LG&E is providing the following updated information in electronic medium:

• PSC-1 Question No. 43 - updated Blake Exhibit 2 and Analysis of Embedded Cost of Capital to reflect changes through October 31, 2012 and Reference Schedule 1.09 to reflect off-system sales margins through October 31, 2012. In accordance with Ordering Paragraph 8 of the June 22, 2012 Order, the confidential information that is the subject of LG&E's July 13, 2012 Petition for Confidential Protection is not included in the electronic submission of this filing. The original and two copies of the Petition in paper medium and one copy of the confidential information in paper medium and on CD ROM were filed under separate cover by counsel.

- PSC-1 Question No. 44 detailed monthly income statements for October 2012.
- PSC-1 Question No. 57 updated actual rate case expenses through October 31, 2012.

In accordance with Ordering Paragraphs 5 and 10 of the Commission's June 22, 2012 Order, I certify that the electronically filed documents are a true representation of the documents in paper medium being filed by hand-delivery with the Commission within two business days from the date of this electronic filing, and that all materials in the paper documents are included in the electronic filing.
