**MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION AND AMENDMENT OF ORDER**

Louisville Gas and Electric Company (“LG&E”) and Kentucky Utilities Company (“KU”) (jointly the “Companies”) move for clarification and amendment of the Kentucky Public Service Commission’s (“Commission”) Order of April 30, 2013, in the above-captioned proceeding. The approved program is intended to facilitate the hiring and retention of qualified energy specialists by public school districts through fiscal years 2014 and 2015 to lead the continued expansion of energy efficiency improvements in Kentucky public schools.

In its April 30, 2013 Order, the Commission approved the proposed two-year DSM Energy Management Program for Schools and the proposed changes in the DSM rates and tariffs “as of the date of th[e] Order.” In fact, the Companies intended to request that the new rates and proposed changes become effective on June 1, 2013, in order to begin collecting the costs of the program in the month before the start of the schools’ next fiscal year. As the Companies had originally requested an order by May 31, 2013, the Companies assumed that June 1, 2013 would be the effective date for the rates and tariffs. Because the Commission issued its Order

approving the program on April 30, 2013, the Companies now respectfully request the Commission to expressly approve June 1, 2013 as the effective date of the revised DSM rates and tariffs.

**WHEREFORE**, Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company respectfully requests that the Commission enter an Order granting the clarification and amendment of the April 30, 2013 Order as requested in this Motion.
