The filing consists of 9 volumes. The files are stored in the Monthly Updates folder under W: Rate Administration (W:\Rate Administration\Website Updates\Monthly Tariff Updates).

I doubt the existing upload program will handle this exact naming convention because we never set a convention of "pet" for Petition for Adjustment of Rates. However, the other components of the file name should load. Here is the naming I used and what the entry on the web page should appear as:
