## WATER SERVICE CORPORATION OF KENTUCKY'S MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINES AND AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHDEDULE

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Water Service Corporation of Kentucky ("WSCK"), by counsel, hereby moves for an extension of time to respond to the Commission Staff's Second Request for Information Request and the Attorney General's Initial Request for Information and for a corresponding amendment to the procedural schedule established in this matter. In support thereof, WSCK states as follows:

On October 18, 2013, the Commission entered an order setting forth a procedural schedule in this matter. Consistent with that procedural schedule, Commission Staff and that Attorney General issued information requests on October 25, 2013. The Commission Staff's request was comprised of 23 items with numerous subparts and the Attorney General's request was comprised of 113 items with several subparts. Pursuant to the procedural schedule, WSCK's responses are due on November 8, 2013.

Due to the voluminous nature of the information requests, WSCK moves for a fourteenday extension to respond to both information requests so as to properly and sufficiently respond to the information requests. Recognizing that the parties and Commission Staff should be given an opportunity to review WSCK's responses prior to issuing supplemental information requests, WCSK requests an amendment to the procedural schedule related to the dates for written discovery and written testimony. WSCK proposes that, if the schedule is amended to where the Intervenors' responses to requests for information are due on February 12, 2014, WSCK will agree to file the testimony of any rebuttal witnesses on February 21, 2014. This would enable the informal conference scheduled for February 25, 2014, to remain unchanged.

The undersigned counsel has contacted counsel for the Attorney General and Hickman County Fiscal Court, who have both indicated that their clients have no objection to an extension for WSCK to respond to the information requests so long as there is a commensurate extension for the other deadlines in the procedural schedule.

WHEREFORE, WSCK requests an extension to November 22, 2013, to respond to Commission Staff's Second Request for Information Request and the Attorney General's Initial Request for Information and a corresponding amendment to the procedural schedule related to the deadlines for written discovery and written testimony.
