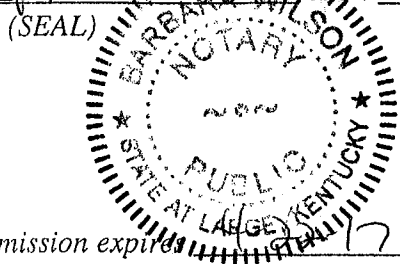

The utility is requesting an increase in annual revenue totaling \$228,789, which will be a total increase of 10.87% to the utility. This filing and any other related documents can be found on the Public Service Commission's Web site at <http://psc.ky.gov/>. Written comments regarding the proposed rate may be submitted to the Public Service Commission by mail or through the Public Service Commission's Web site.

Water Service Corporation of Kentucky has also proposed additions to its tariff to include a Distribution System Infrastructure Charge Rider that would be applied to rates for infrastructure replacement investments. This rider charge would be calculated annually based on actual replacement costs, and applied to each customer's monthly bill. The rider charge would then be updated annually until the next rate case, at which time the investment costs would be incorporated into rates and the rider charge reset at zero.

Water Service Corporation of Kentucky has also proposed additions to its tariff to include a Purchased Power and Chemical Charge Rider that would be applied to rates to establish a base cost per thousand gallons for purchased power and chemical costs. The rider charge would then be calculated annually as a percentage to include increases or decreases in base purchased power and chemical costs per thousand gallons.
