MOTION TO CORRECT ORDER

Kentucky Utilities Company (“KU”), by counsel, hereby respectfully moves the Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to issue an Order *nunc pro tunc* correcting a clerical error in its November 14, 2013 Order (“Final Order”) in this proceeding.

As stated on page 4 of the Final Order under the section titled Surcharge Roll-In the amount of the incremental roll-in is correctly stated as \$45,820,651. However, in ordering paragraph 4, at page 8, first line, the amount is incorrectly stated as \$45,821,651. (Emphasis added.) KU asks this clerical error in the Final Order be corrected from \$45,821,651 to \$45,820,651.

WHEREFORE, Kentucky Utilities Company respectfully requests the Commission to issue an order *nunc pro tunc* correcting this clerical error at the Commission’s earliest convenience.
