# LOUISVILLE GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY'S AND KENTUCKY UTILITIES COMPANY'S MOTION TO EXTEND ABEYANCE OF PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") and Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") (collectively, the "Companies") respectfully request the Commission to extend its abeyance of the procedural schedule in this case until after the August 12, 2014 informal conference.

By Order of May 5, 2014 and upon the Companies' uncontested April 30, 2014 Motion to Hold Procedural Schedule in Abeyance, the Commission held the procedural schedule in this case in abeyance for a period of 90 days. The Commission's May 5, 2014 Order also scheduled an informal conference to occur on August 7, 2014. By Order of July 18, 2014, the Commission rescheduled the informal conference for August 12, 2014, which falls well beyond the end of the original 90-day abeyance period. Out of an abundance of caution and to ensure there are no timing complications in the procedure of this case, the Companies hereby move the Commission to extend the original 90-day abeyance period until after the August 12, 2014 informal conference. Such an extension will allow the Commission to establish a revised procedural

schedule for the case after receiving input from the parties at the informal conference as to the remaining issues in the case.

**WHEREFORE**, the Companies respectfully request that the Commission extend the abeyance period in this case until after the August 12, 2104 informal conference.
