**MOTION FOR DISPOSITION OF  
FORMERLY CONFIDENTIAL MATERIALS**

Louisville Gas and Electric Company (“LG&E”) and Kentucky Utilities Company (“KU”) (jointly, the “Companies”) move the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) for certain disposition of materials that were submitted confidentially over five years ago, but are now no longer confidential due to the passage of time. In support of this motion, the Companies state as follows:

1. By Petition for Confidential Treatment dated March 27, 2014, the Companies sought confidential protection of certain of their discovery responses containing commercially sensitive information. The Companies requested those responses be treated confidentially for a period of five years. For that category of the confidential responses and as described the Companies’ March 28, 2014 Motion for Deviation, the Companies submitted most of them on an external hard drive with the label “confidential” affixed to the hard drive. The remainder of the responses were submitted in hard copy format under confidential seal.

2. By Order dated August 26, 2019, the Commission noted that the requested five-year period of confidentiality had passed, and, therefore, in Ordering Paragraph 8, directed the

Companies to “file revised pages reflecting as unredacted the designated materials.” no later than September 25, 2019. For the responses the Companies submitted in hard copy format under confidential seal, they will electronically file the responses in an unredacted format as directed by the Commission. However, for the voluminous files on the external hard drive the Companies submitted, the Companies respectfully request that the Commission simply remove the affixed “confidential” label and then physically relocate that hard drive from the Commission’s confidential materials area to the public case file for this case. That way, the hard drive will be available for public inspection and the Companies will be able to save the resources that would otherwise be spent in duplicating and delivering a duplicate of the hard drive already in the Commission’s possession.

**WHEREFORE**, Louisville Gas and Electric Company and Kentucky Utilities Company move the Commission for certain disposition of formerly confidential materials as described above.
