## Dear Mr. DeRouen:

On January 17, 2014 and pursuant to KRS 278.020 and 807 KAR 5:001, Sections 14 and 15(2), Louisville Gas and Electric Company's ("LG&E") and Kentucky Utilities Company's ("KU") (collectively "the Companies") filed a Joint Application seeking Certificates of Public Convenience and Necessity for the construction of an approximately 700 MW net summer rating natural gas combined cycle combustion turbine facility at KU's Green River Generating Station in Muhlenberg County, Kentucky, including a 20-inch natural gas pipeline to serve that facility, and an approximately 10 MW solar photovoltaic facility at KU's E.W. Brown Generating Station in Mercer County, Kentucky.

Enclosed please find and accept for filing a supplement to Mr. David S. Sinclair's Testimony, Exhibit DSS-1, Appendix A. Appendix A is a summary of responses to the Companies' September 2012 Request for Proposals, Self-Build Alternatives, and DSM Programs considered by the Companies. Althought all the information in the enclosed supplemental Appendix A was fully considered in the analyses by the Companies, we recently realized that the Appendix A that was filed on January 17, 2014 inadvertently omitted some data from the summary page. Therefore, we submit the attached revised Appendix A, which includes the previously omitted data.

The Companies filed a Petition for Confidential Protection of Mr. Sinclair's Testimony and Exhibit DSS-1 on January 17, 2014. For the same reasons stated in that Petition, the Companies request confidential protection of the information in this filing.
