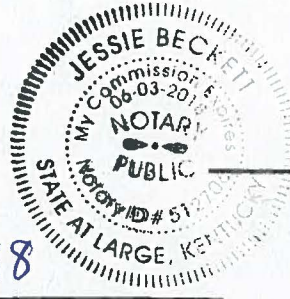

**CITY OF FALMOUTH
ORDINANCE 2014- 51.14AA**

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING CITY OF FALMOUTH AD VALOREM TAX FOR FISCAL PURPOSES FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OF 2014/2015 ON PERSONAL MOTOR VEHICLES AND WATER CRAFT, WITHIN THE TAXING JURISDICTION OF FALMOUTH SHALL BE AT THE RATE OF \$.750 PER ONE HUNDRED ASSESSED VALUATION.

Be it ordained by the City of Falmouth:

Section 1. That for the purpose of general support of the government the payment of its debts and expenses for the fiscal year of 2014-2015, there be taxes on each one hundred (\$100.00) dollars of the January 1, 2014 assessed value of personal property, other than motor vehicles, within the taxing jurisdiction of the City of Falmouth, which shall be at the rate of .750.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval required by law, with an effective date of 9-16-14.
