## Exhibit P Permits

- Critical permits required for the development, design, engineering, financing, procurement, construction, and operation of the Project, include but are not limited to those detailed below.
   Required permits must be obtained prior to the start of construction.
  - 1. Owner's Responsibility:

The Contractor shall assist Owner in obtaining, preparing, and maintaining the necessary following permits required in the name of the Owner and shall obtain and maintain all other permits and licenses as applicable.

- a. Prevention of Significant Deterioration (PSD) permit
- b. Construction Permit
- c. Title V Operating Permit including New Source Review (NSR)
- d. Kentucky Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (KPDES) Operating Permit
- e. Site Compatibility Certificate
- 2. Contractor's Responsibility:

The Contractor shall secure and pay for any and all construction related Permits, certificates, or licenses not listed above which are required in connection with the performance of the Work. Any other statute or non-statutory clearance/permits including but not limited to:

- Compliance as required with federal, state, or local requirements in as far as
  these are applicable to the design, manufacture, supply, and erection of the
  equipment and the work required for erection and commissioning on Site
- Also any documentation associated with these permits and approvals, as may be required for the ongoing operation of the plant, shall be made available to Owner prior to Substantial Completion
- c. Federal and state requirements applicable to construction and operation safety and health (such as OSHA)
- d. Kentucky Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (KPDES) Storm Water
  Discharges (SWPPP), during Construction Permit, including Spill Prevention,
  Control, and Countermeasure Plans (SPCC), and Best Management Practices
  (BMP)

- e. Erosion and Sedimentation Control Plan approval
- f. Building permits
- g. Plant safety permits, e.g., hot work
- h. Hydrostatic Discharge Request (with KYDOW)
- i. Demolition Permits
- j. Contractor generated waste management programs consistent with RCRA,
   CERCLA and other applicable laws. Waste Management includes the
   TSD of generated wastes by EPC Contractor
