MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Comes Shelby Energy Cooperative, Inc. ("Shelby Energy"), by counsel, and respectfully moves the Commission for an extension of time to file Shelby Energy's Responses to the Commission Staff's First Request for Information and Production of Documents to Shelby Energy Cooperative, Inc. As grounds for this request, Shelby Energy states that its response was ready to be filed on Monday September 15, 2014; however, prior to submitting that response, Shelby Energy made one last effort to locate the documents requested by the Commission. A copy of a map was located, which Shelby Energy believes is likely the October 18, 1988 agreement. A January 13, 1994 letter was also located which may be relevant.
