Question No. 1

Responding Witness: Tim Webb, General Manager

- Q-1. Refer to the May 13, 2019 Order, ordering paragraph 8, which authorized Cannonsburg District to assess a monthly surcharge of \$4.00 for a period of 48 months or until the total amount of the surcharge asset equals \$680,000, whichever comes first. Provide the total amount of the surcharge that has been collected through the most recent billing cycle.
- A-1. Cannonsburg District discontinued the billing of the Surcharge effective July 1, 2023. The last bill containing the Surcharge was mailed to the customers on July 17, 2023 for water used during the month of June. As of the most recent billing cycle, Cannonsburg District's billing system (MuniLink) provides that the total amount of the Surcharge billed is \$693,100.88 and the total amount collected is \$683,680.27.

Cannonsburg District billed the Monthly Surcharge for 48 months as provided in the Commission's May 13, 2019 Order in this case. After the 47th Surcharge bill had been mailed to its customers, Cannonsburg District had not yet collected \$680,000. Thus, it was authorized to bill the Surcharge for an additional month. It would not have been fair to bill some of its customers for the Surcharge and not bill all its customers. The 48th bill resulted in Cannonsburg District collecting less than \$4,000 above the maximum permitted by the May 12, 2019 Order.

- Q-3. In a numbered list, provide all water loss reduction projects that have been started or completed since the collection of the surcharge. Include any projects that have not been funded by the surcharge collections.
- A-3. One project has been started and completed since the collection of the Surcharge. No other projects have been funded by the Surcharge Account to date.
 - The Phase I Zone Meter Project was bid in March of 2020 and completed in December of 2020. The total cost of the Phase I Project was \$819,103. As authorized by the Commission in its June 4, 2020 Order in Case No. 2020-118, this Phase I Project was funded by a KIA Loan in the amount of \$622,000 and the use of \$197,103 of residual proceeds from the First Surcharge approved by the Commission. Exhibit 4-3 to this Response is an amortization schedule for the KIA Loan showing semi-annual principal and interest payments of \$81,289.36 on each June 1 and December 1 for four (4) years. The last payment will be made on

December 1, 2024. All these loan payments have been made from the Water Loss Reduction Surcharge bank account.

- A-4. (a) The Phase I Zone Meter Project included the installation of 53 Zone
 Meters throughout various areas of the system and created virtual metering
 groups for those areas.
 - (b) The Phase I Zone Meter Project was completed in December 2020.

(c) The Phase I Zone Meter Project used a total of \$197,103.00 in surcharge funds from the First Surcharge. As stated in the response to Question 3, the balance of the Phase I Project was paid for by a KIA Loan in the amount of \$622,000. The KIA Loan is being repaid with surcharge funds which were collected pursuant to the Commission's May 13, 2019 Order. (d) Cannonsburg District currently has a new upcoming project, the ShopesCreek Road Project. Cannonsburg District intends to ask the Commissionfor authority to use surcharge funds for this new project.

(e) The Phase I Zone Meter Project was completed in December 2020. The Shopes Creek Project has yet to be bid.

If the Office Manager is not in the office on that day, or if the last day of the month falls on a weekend, the Office Manager completes the transfers during the beginning of the following month.
