Please take a moment to review the status and actions Cannonsburg Water District has taken this month to gain control of its water loss.

The Shopes Creek Phase II Water Loss Project is near completion with permitting and some minor design changes. Funding was also approved by KIA for this project during their July meeting. At this time, we will also be meeting with our area Ad District to look at additional Cleaner Water Grant Funding that is to become available later this year. At this time that amount looks to be in the \$500,000 range for this project. This additional amount, if approved, will greatly help in the financing of this project.

Overall leak detection and repair efforts are going well however, due to availability of repair parts, repairs are becoming difficult at times. Brass parts and PVC pipe are the two most difficult items to get at this time.

The KYTC US Route 60 Project has contributed to the August water loss due to KYTC contactor causing four water line breaks during road construction. Cannonsburg has made contractor and inspectors aware of the importance of water line safety and protection in hopes that this trend is not continued in the future.
