

**Motion For Leave To Withdraw Portion Of February 11, 2015 Petition For Confidential Treatment Relating To The Company's Response To KIUC 1-68 Only**

Kentucky Power Company moves the Public Service Commission of Kentucky for leave to withdraw that portion of its February 11, 2015 Petition for Confidential Treatment seeking to protect from public disclosure the Company's response to KIUC 1-68 until "such time ... [as] the retirement of Big Sandy Unit 2 is made public." The retirement of Big Sandy Unit 2 has been made public and thus the need for confidential treatment no longer exists.

Wherefore, Kentucky Power respectfully requests that it be permitted to withdraw that portion of its February 11, 2015 petition for confidential treatment as it relates to the Company's response to KIUC 1-68 only.
