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(e) Other Matters – The July 2022 Tariff C.C. filing will reflect the reduced 2022 annual Tariff C.C. charges associated with the termination of the Rockport Unit Power Agreement on December 7, 2022. The rates will be designed to recover \$2,692,329 (\$5,792,329 minus \$3,100,000 (50 percent of \$6,200,000)) as adjusted to reflect any over-recovery or under-recovery for the period ending June 30, 2022.
