- 2. Refer to the Willhite Testimony, page 9, lines 1-4.
 - a. Confirm that Mr. Willhite is recommending that Kentucky Power Company be directed to add a new tariff, Rate LGS-School, with lower rates than the current LGS tariff. If this cannot be confirmed, explain the recommendation. If this can be confirmed, provide the rates that Mr. Willhite would propose for the new tariff.
 - b. If a LGS-School tariff were created, state whether Mr. Willhite would recommend that all school accounts automatically be moved to the tariff or that schools would be required to request it.

Response:

- a. Mr. Willhite would propose that Tariff K-12 School be set at 95 percent of the demand and energy charges of the final Tariff L.G.S. schedule.
- b. Schools would be permitted to switch at their option.
