Motion To Deviate

Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power”) moves the Commission pursuant to 807 KAR 5:001, Section 22, for leave to deviate from the requirements of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(3) and 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8(12)(b) with respect to certain of its responses to Staff’s First Set of Data Requests. Specifically, Kentucky Power requests that it be excused from filing a single paper original of all or a portion of its responses to certain data requests, and that instead it be granted leave to file those portions of the requests comprising an Excel spreadsheet in electronic format on the enclosed disc. 


