Kentucky Power Company's
Response To "Motion To Amend Procedural Schedule
Of Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc."

Kentucky Power Company for its response to the February 27, 2015 motion by Kentucky Industrial Utility Customers, Inc. to amend the Commission's February 5, 2015 Procedural Schedule states:

1. The hearing in this matter currently is scheduled for April 7, 2015. KIUC's motion seeks to amend the current procedural schedule to permit it to file its testimony on the day, April 8, 2015, following the currently scheduled hearing date. Granting KIUC's motion would require rescheduling the current hearing.
2. The hearing in Case No. 2014-00396, the Company's rate case, currently is scheduled to begin on May 5, 2015.
3. Due process requires that Kentucky Power be provided with a reasonable opportunity to serve discovery and file written rebuttal testimony if the intervenors are permitted to file testimony in this case. Any such period would require the Company to file its rebuttal immediately prior to or during the hearing in Case No. 2014-00396 and would unreasonably interfere with the Company's ability to prosecute its rate case.

4. Kentucky Power does not object to KIUC's motion if the Company is permitted to file its rebuttal testimony ten days after the conclusion of the hearing in Case No. 2014-00396.

WHEREFORE, Kentucky Power Company respectfully requests the Commission to enter an Order:


1. Amending the procedural schedule to grant the Company at least ten days following the filing of the intervenors' testimony to file its written discovery regarding the intervenors' testimony;

2. Granting Kentucky Power ten days following the conclusion of the hearing in Case No. 2014-00396 to file its rebuttal test;

3. Continuing the hearing in Case No. 2014-00450 to a reasonable period following the filing of the Company's rebuttal testimony; and

4. Granting Kentucky Power all further relief to which it may be entitled.
