MOTION TO RESCHEDULE CONFERENCE

- 4. If the conference cannot be rescheduled to another date, then Bracken District requests that the time of the conference be changed to the morning to permit Counsel to participate in the conference by telephone.
 - 5. This motion is not made for purposes of delay.

WHEREFORE, Bracken District requests an Order setting a different date for the conference scheduled for September 1, 2015 in this matter or, in the alternative, establishing an earlier starting time for the conference.
