JOINT MOTION TO HOLD PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE IN ABEYANCE

The City of Augusta ("Augusta") and Bracken County Water District ("Bracken District") (collectively "Movants") jointly move for an Order holding this proceeding in abeyance for 21 days to permit the parties to continue settlement discussions. In support of their motion, the Movants state:

1. On June 5, 2015, the Movants held settlement discussions in Augusta, Kentucky. They agreed that Bracken District would submit a proposal to the Augusta City Council for its consideration regarding the ownership, management and operation of Augusta's Water Treatment Plant and that this proposal will be considered at the Augusta City Council's next regularly scheduled meeting on June 17, 2015.

2. If the Augusta City Council favorably considers Bracken District's proposal at the June 17, 2015 meeting, the Movants will enter into more detailed settlement discussions for a global settlement of all disputed issues pertaining to the Augusta Water Treatment, including the appropriate rate for service rendered for the one-year period ending June 30, 2014.

3. The Movants will notify the Commission of the status of their settlement discussions no later June 24, 2015 and advise whether the proceedings should continue to be held in abeyance.

WHEREFORE, Movants requests an Order holding this proceeding in abeyance until July 1, 2015 to permit them to continue settlement discussions.
