## SECOND REPORT ON SETTLEMENT DISCUSSIONS

The City of Augusta ("Augusta") and Bracken County Water District ("Bracken District") jointly submit this Report on the status of their discussions to resolve this matter.

- 1. On July 12, 2015, Augusta advised Bracken District by letter that Bracken District's proposal of June 12, 2015 was "not currently feasibly" and made a counterproposal.
- 2. Bracken District is currently reviewing the counterproposal and expects to advise Augusta of its position in writing shortly.
- 3. As settlement discussions are continuing, the Commission proceedings should continue to be held in abeyance to allow the parties an opportunity to resolve their differences.
- 4. No later than August 24, 2015, Augusta and Bracken District will file another report with the Commission on the status of their discussions.

WHEREFORE, Augusta and Bracken District respectfully request that the Commission continue to hold this proceeding in abeyance to permit them to continue settlement discussions.
