- 1. Pages 1 through 12 of Exhibit 3 of the March 18, 2015 filing contain social security numbers of current or former City of Augusta employees.
- 2. When Bracken District originally filed these pages, which contain wage information on each employee who performed work for Augusta's Water Treatment Plant during Fiscal Year 2013-2014 and which Augusta had provided to Bracken District, it failed to detect that all digits of an employee's social security number appeared at the top of each page.
- 3. Public Service Commission Rules of Procedure require the redaction of such information from papers. 807 KAR 5:001, Section 4(10).
- 4. On the proposed substitute pages, Bracken District has redacted each instance of a nine-digit social security numbers and each instance of the last four digits of a social security number.

WHEREFORE, Bracken District requests that the attached pages be substituted for pages 1 through 12 of Exhibit 3 of its filing of March 18, 2015.
